

Shawl Bay Renewed for 2009

Broughton Archipelago Chart 3515

(through Sept 30, 2009)

Shawl Bay is at the mouth of Kingcome Inlet, 7nm north of Echo Bay.

RVYC and Saltspring Island Sailing Club (SISC) have agreed jointly with Shawl Bay Marina to lease 140 feet of moorage on one side of Shawl Bay Marina's newest dock, with 70 feet of dock allotted to each Club. RVYC has prepaid moorage for the 2009 season - there is no moorage charge to Club members. Individual members will pay for any power used. Club members may exceed the allotted RVYC 70 feet BUT ONLY if there is no SISC vessel alongside, or if no SISC member has made a reservation for that night.

The following procedures and conditions govern RVYC's moorage at Shawl Bay:

1. RVYC members MUST be moored up, or have made a reservation for that day prior to 1500 hours, after which time Shawl Bay may rent the space to other guests. Reservations are strongly encouraged, and can be made by phone (250-483-4169), or VHF Radio, Channel 66A. If Shawl Bay rents RVYC's space, Shawl Bay will move any non-member boat from RVYC space by 1000 hours the following morning.
2. Members must fly the RVYC burgee.
3. Rafting to a fellow member's boat is permissible to a maximum of one vessel, and is subject to the concurrence of the Marina manager.
4. Length of each stay is not limited, providing there are no other members of the Club waiting for moorage, in which case a three day maximum will apply. Agreements are permissible between RVYC members to pay for fellow member's moorage elsewhere in the Marina.
5. RVYC members must attend their boats when moored on these facilities so that re-positioning, if required, is possible.
6. Power is available when Shawl Bay's generator is operating (generally 0700 to 1100 hours, and 1600 to 2300 hours). If used, power is to be paid for by RVYC members, directly to Shawl Bay Marina.
7. Club rules governing conduct at RVYC Outstations (2007 Annual, page 146) will generally apply, the exceptions being that reservations shall be made directly with Shawl Bay Marina, and that rafting is limited to one boat. Directions of our host LorneBrown supercede all Club rules and guidelines.
8. Members must respect Shawl Bay Marina's guidelines regarding boat washing, noise, pets, sewage discharge and general boating etiquette.
