1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* including the prescriptions of the CYA

2 ADVERTISING

Advertising will be restricted to category A.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to one-design dinghy classes with a minimum of 5 entries. Classes that do not meet this requirement will be started together and scored with North American Portsmouth numbers. We anticipate classes to include Fireballs, 29ers, 420s, 470s, Lasers, Radials, Megabytes, Bytes, and Optis.
- 3.2 Participants are required to complete the attached Waiver and mail or fax it to the Royal Victoria Yacht Club at the address and fax number provided below. **Participants under the age of 18 must have the waiver signed by a parent or guardian. This includes the crew of double handed boats.** Competitors must check in at the registration desk between 800 and 1000 February 4, 2012.
- 3.3 Registration closes at 10:00am February 4, 2012.
- 3.4 Registration is in person, main lounge, Royal Victoria Yacht Club Saturday February 4, 2012 between 8:00 – 10:00 A.M.

4 CLASSIFICATION

The ISAF Sailor Classification Code will apply.

5 FEES

- \$35 Cdn - Optimist class
- \$35 Cdn - Single-Handed Boats
- \$70 Cdn - Double-Handed Boats

H.S.T. included in fees.

6 SCHEDULE

Saturday, February 4, 2012

- 8:00 – 10:00 Registration and check-in RVYC Main Lounge.
- 10:00 Competitors Meeting on Foreshore of RVYC.
- 11:00 Warning Signal for first race of the day, subsequent races will follow.

Sunday, February 5, 2012

- 10:00 Warning Signal for first race of the day, subsequent races will follow.
- 14:30 No warning signal will be made after 14:30.

Prizes will be awarded in the Main Lounge approximately one hour after the last boat finishes.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available after 8:00 at the regatta registration desk.

8 RACING AREA

The regatta will take place in the vicinity of Cadboro Bay and Oak Bay.

9 COURSES

Courses will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

10 SAFETY

Competitors shall wear CCG or (USCG for US citizens) approved flotation devices at all times while on the water. It may be removed briefly only to adjust clothing. All boats must carry a 15m long, minimum 7mm diameter, buoyant towline tied to the mast.

11 PENALTY SYSTEM

For the 29er class only, rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

12 SCORING

12.1 Low point scoring shall be used.

12.2 A series will consist of a minimum of one race per class. There will be no maximum number of races. When 5 or less races have been completed a boats series will be the total of her races. If more than 5 races are completed, a boats score will be the total of her races excluding her worst score.

13 MEALS

The following meals will be provided and included in the entry fee:

- **Saturday February 4, 2012 – Dinner after racing has concluded**
- Sunday February 5, 2012 – On the water lunch between races

14 PRIZES

Prizes will be determined upon closure of registration.

15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta and each race entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
