The Review will be followed by an air show featuring the Snowbirds and the Skyhawks parachute team.</p>
<p>When?</p>	<p>1000hrs on Saturday 12 June 2010 The event will be over by ~1300hrs.</p>
<p>Where?</p>	<p>South of Saxe Point has been assigned to the RVYC Flotilla.</p>
<p>Who?</p>	<p>Our Governor General Her Excellency the Right Honourable Michaëlle Jean will be embarked on HMCS ALGONQUIN along with Rear Admiral Pile and Commodore Scott plus many other dignitaries.</p>
<p>How?</p>	<p>RVYC Flotilla Parade participants are expected to dress their boats overall, and the crew should wear blazers & whites. The Greater Victoria Harbour Authority has extended complimentary moorage for a limited number of participating RVYC yachts on Friday night 11 June on their causeway docks. These spots will be assigned by the Coordinator Don Thain by <u>advanced reservation</u> only.</p>
<p>Other?</p>	<p>A Fireworks Display will occur on Friday night starting at 2200hrs from a barge located off Esquimalt Lagoon. Spectator boats can approach no closer than Saxe Point. There is a flood current from 1000hrs until 1800hrs.</p>
